As the first term of 2015/2016 draws to a close we reflect on what has been another busy term and give you a flavour of some of the events which took place in the school.

External Speakers/Volunteers/Coaches: Maurice Leahy has been providing hurling coaching to 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Classes every second Monday since 7<sup>th</sup> September.
